The Port of Gabès , The Gulf of Gabès at 34° N 10.4166667° E. The gulf is 100 kilometers long and wide, with the Kerkena Islands on the northeast and Djerba Island on the southeast. It has a large tidal range, 2.5 meters at spring tides.

Highlights

Matmata - Gabes

Visit of the underground village of Matmata (coulisse of the Star War series). Actually built into the mountain, this fabulous Berber village with its pitted lunar landscapes was used by Spielberg in the production of both Star Wars and Raiders of the Lost Arc. Way to Gabes : visit the local market of spices

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Medenine – Tataouine - Chenini

Departure to Medenine: visit of the Ghorfas fascinating dwellings once used by nomad tribes as storehouses and then as shelter. The hill top villages of Chenini, Douiret, and Guemessa offer splendid panoramas and a final glimpse of traditional Berber life. Clinging to the craggy mountain ridges, ksours and empty ghorfas await the return of the Berber people who sought protection behind their ochre walls and who stored their precious grain in the honeycomb like granaries.

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
